Luke 21:29-38

- I. We need to recognize the signs that God gives (vv. 29-31).
 - A. God repeatedly shows His power over creation (vv. 29-30).
 - B. God will reveal when His kingdom is near (v. 31).

II. We need to rest in the fact that God is in control (vv. 32-33).

A. God retains people until His timing (v. 32).

B. God relays His word for all eternity (v. 33).

III. We need to remove our thoughts from the cares of this life (vv. 34-38).

A. God wants us ready for the return of Jesus (vv. 34-35).

B. God will reward those who have been alert (v. 36).

C. Jesus reached out to people with truth (vv. 37-38).
