

Thinking Biblically

Luke 22:24-30

- I. **Worldly thinking results in self-exaltation (vv. 24-25).**
 - A. **The disciples argued about their standing (v. 24).**
 - B. **Jesus confronted them as being sinful (v. 25).**

- II. Righteous thinking results in service (vv. 26-27).
 - A. Jesus instructed that leaders are to sacrifice (v. 26).
 - B. Jesus reversed their thinking of the status quo (v. 27).

III. Future thinking results in surrender (vv. 28-30).

A. The disciples had seen Jesus suffering (v. 28).

B. Jesus promises His disciples will be satisfied (vv. 29-30).

Conclusion:

Are you looking for ways to exalt yourself?

Do you understand that Jesus has called us to think differently from the world?

Are you able to focus on the promises that believers have been given about the future?

Are you satisfied in the promise of Christ's return for His own?
