I THESSALONIANS 3:1-5

I. We walk in a manner worthy of God when we encourage (vv. 1-2).

A. Paul's desire to disciple brought excruciating pain (v. 1).

B. Paul was determined to help establish their faith (v. 2).

II. We walk in a manner worthy of God when we endure (vv. 3-4).

A. It is God's will for believers to experience persecution (v. 3a).

B. God's Word tells us to expect persecution (vv. 3b-4).

III. We walk in a manner worthy of God when we examine (v. 5).

A. We should enquire about the faith of others (v. 5a).

B. We must expose Satan's schemes (v. 5b).
