### THE CALL TO REPENTANCE

### I. Jesus <u>rose</u> from the dead (vv. 29-32).

A. Peter spoke <u>regarding</u> David's Psalm (vv. 29-30).

B. The Psalm taught that Jesus would not <u>remain</u> in the tomb (vv. 31-32).

#### **II.** Jesus <u>returned</u> to the Father (vv. 33-36).

- A. Jesus is now at the <u>right</u> hand of the Father (v. 33).
- B. David <u>realized</u> the Messiah would come through him (vv. 34-35).
- C. Sinners must <u>recognize</u> Jesus as Messiah (v. 36).

## III. Salvation demands <u>repentance</u> of sin (vv. 37-41).

- A. The Holy Spirit <u>reached</u> into their hearts (v. 37).
- B. Peter explained what was <u>required</u> (vv. 38-39).
- C. Genuine salvation <u>results</u> in a change (vv. 40-41).
