## **FACING THE OPPOSITION**

Nehemiah 4:1-9

I. The people of God are <u>ridiculed</u> by others (vv. 1-3).

A. The enemies did not like that they were <u>rebuilding</u> (v. 1).

B. The enemies did not think they could <u>revive</u> the walls (vv. 2-3).

**II.** The people of God are <u>resolved</u> to continue (vv. 4-6). A. Nehemiah <u>reached</u> out to God for help (vv. 4-5). **B.** The people of God <u>remained</u> steadfast in the work (v. 6).

III. The people of God are <u>relying</u> on God's help (vv. 7-9).

A. The enemies were frustrated that the <u>repairs</u> continued (vv. 7-8).

B. The people of God <u>refused</u> to be stopped (v. 9).
