Acts 4:1-22

- I. The resurrection of Jesus may <u>agitate</u> some (vv. 1-4).
 - A. Some are <u>annoyed</u> by the message of Jesus (vv. 1-3).
 - B. Many <u>accepted</u> the message about Jesus (v. 4).

- II. The power of Jesus may <u>attract</u> some (vv. 5-12).
 - A. They are questioned about the <u>allocation</u> of their power (vv. 5-7).
 - B. They respond by <u>attributing</u> their power to Jesus (vv. 8-12).

- III. The confidence from Jesus may <u>amaze</u> some (vv. 13-22).
 - A. God can make your fiercest <u>adversary</u> speechless (vv. 13-14).
 - B. God's work is apparent to all (vv. 15-18).
 - C. They remained faithful <u>allowing</u> God to work out the details (vv. 19-22).
