FORTIFIED AGAINST ATTACK

Nehemiah 6:1-9

- I. Enemies tried to harm Nehemiah <u>physically</u> (vv. 1-4).
 - A. The enemies were making a <u>plan</u> (vv. 1-2).
 - B. The enemies were <u>persistent</u> (vv. 3-4).

- II. Enemies tried to harm Nehemiah politically (vv. 5-7).
 - A. The enemies tried to <u>publicly</u> shame Nehemiah (vv. 5-6).
 - B. The enemies accused Nehemiah of hiring prophets (v. 7).

- III. Nehemiah responded to the <u>proclamations</u> (vv. 8-9).
 - A. Nehemiah said the allegations were phony (v. 8).
 - B. Nehemiah knew they wanted to <u>prevent</u> the work (v. 9a).
 - C. Nehemiah turned to God in prayer (v. 9b).
