Jonah 4:1-11

- i. Jonah knows the Lord is compassionate (vv. 1-4).
 - A. The character of the Lord must direct our actions (vv. 1-2).
 - B. The corruption of our heart must be addressed (vv. 3-4).

- II. Jonah is affected by external circumstances (vv. 5-8).
 - A. Jonah is content to relax (vv. 5-6).
 - B. Jonah is focused on his personal comfort (vv. 7-8).

III. God calls Jonah to be concerned about others (vv. 9-11).

A. Jonah is consumed with himself (v. 9).

B. The Lord cares about people (vv. 10-11).
