

THROUGH LOVE SERVE ONE ANOTHER

Galatians 5:7-15

- I. God will always <u>direct</u> us toward truth (vv. 7-9).
 - A. <u>Disdain</u> of the truth is plentiful (v. 7).
 - B. <u>Disrespect</u> of truth does not come from God (v. 8).
 - C. <u>Deviation</u> from the truth is detrimental (v. 9).

- II. God will always <u>deal</u> with troublemakers (vv. 10-12).
 - A. God will <u>decide</u> the judgment of troublemakers (v. 10).
 - B. Paul was <u>determined</u> to preach faith alone (v. 11).
 - C. Paul was <u>disgusted</u> with doctrinal error (v. 12).

III. God always <u>desires</u> for us to love others (vv. 13-15).

A. Freedom in Christ <u>drives</u> us toward others (vv. 13-14).

B. Freedom in Christ <u>dissolves</u> selfishness (v. 15).
