

WALKING BY THE SPIRIT

Galatians 5:16-21

- I. Walking by the Spirit <u>requires</u> an uncompromising submission (vv. 16-18).
 - A. Believers are to <u>respond</u> to the guidance of the Holy Spirit (v. 16).
 - B. Believers are to <u>realize</u> the battle within (v. 17).
 - C. Believers are to <u>reject</u> the demands of the law (v. 18).

- II. The deeds of the flesh <u>result</u> in an uncontrolled life (vv. 19-21a).
 - A. The deeds of the flesh are <u>readily</u> noticeable (v. 19a).
 - B. The deeds of the flesh are <u>repulsive</u> to God (vv. 19b-21a).

III. The deeds of the flesh <u>reveal</u> an unregenerate heart (v. 21b).

A. Paul' concern was with <u>repeated</u> action.

B. Paul's point was with <u>redemption</u> evidence.
