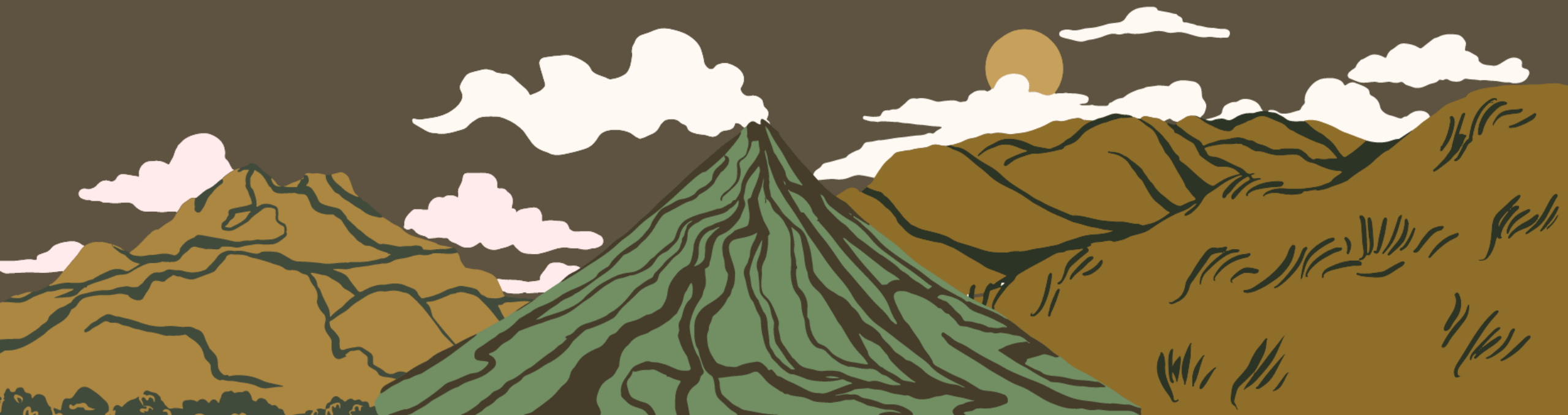

- I. The people were excited about possessing the land (vv. 1-6).
 - A. The people needed to be patient (vv. 1-4).
 - B. The people needed to be prepared (vv. 5-6).

II. The Lord would make His presence known to the people (vv. 7-13).

A. The Lord wanted the people to know Joshua's position as leader (vv. 7-8).

B. The Lord wanted the people to see the priests' feet (vv. 9-13).

III. The Lord would make His power known to the people (vv. 14-17).

A. The Lord performed a miracle at the precise time (vv. 14-16).

B. The Lord performed a miracle in a perfect manner (v. 17).
