- I. The people were excited about <u>possessing</u> the land (vv. 1-6).
 - A. The people needed to be <u>patient</u> (vv. 1-4).
 - B. The people needed to be <u>prepared</u> (vv. 5-6).

II. The Lord would make His <u>presence</u> known to the people (vv. 7-13).

A. The Lord wanted the people to know Joshua's <u>position</u> as leader (vv. 7-8).

B. The Lord wanted the people to see the <u>priests</u>' feet (vv. 9-13).

III. The Lord would make His <u>power</u> known to the people (vv. 14-17).

A. The Lord performed a miracle at the <u>precise</u> time (vv. 14-16).

B. The Lord performed a miracle in a <u>perfect</u> manner (v. 17).
