Acts 23:25-24:9

- I. A letter is sent to explain the situation (vv. 25-30).
 - A. Lysias presents himself in the best possible light (vv. 25-27).
 - B. Lysias determines the accusations are about Jewish law (vv. 28-30).

II. The Lord arranges for Paul to be moved (vv. 31-35).

A. Paul is led to safety (vv. 31-32).

B. Felix learns about Paul's home area (vv. 33-35).

III. A lawyer is sent to present charges (vv. 1-9).

A. Tertullus lavishes praise on Felix (vv. 1-4).

B. Paul is accused of being the leader of a religious sect (vv. 5-8a).

C. The accusations are presented as legitimate (vv. 8b-9).
