- A. The Jews offer no proof (vv. 6-7).
- B. Paul pleads his innocence (v. 8).

III. Festus is politically motivated (vv. 9-12).

- A. Festus presents Paul an option (v. 9).
- B. Paul petitions Caesar (vv. 10-11).
- C. Festus permits Paul's request (v. 12).
