

JESUS: OUR ONLY HOPE

Acts 26:1-11

- I. Paul is permitted to speak (vv. 1-3).
 - A. He is in a place to speak to a king (vv. 1-2).
 - B. He requests the king to be patient (v. 3).

II. Paul emphasizes the promise of God (vv. 4-8).

A. It is common knowledge that Paul is a Pharisee (vv. 4-5).

B. The resurrection of the dead is the accepted position (vv. 6-8).

III. Paul recounts his past (vv. 9-11).

A. He put Christians in prison (vv. 9-10).

B. He pursued Christians (v. 11).
