
The Suffering of Our Savior

- I. The <u>surprising</u> appearance of our Savior (vv. 1-3).
 - A. His appearance was simple (vv. 1-2).
 - B. His acceptance was scarce (v. 3).

II. The substitutionary death of our Savior (vv. 4-6).

A. He bore our sin (v. 4).

B. He suffered on our behalf (vv. 5-6).

- III. The <u>sacrificial</u> willingness of our Savior (vv. 7-9).
 - A. He silently died in our place (vv. 7-8).
 - B. He was the perfect spotless Lamb (v. 9).

- IV. The <u>satisfactory</u> atonement of our Savior (vv. 10-12).
 - A. He <u>submitted</u> to the will of the Father (vv. 10-11).
 - B. He secured our salvation (v. 12).
