 - A. Job wants God's hand removed (vv. 8-10).**
 - B. Job is out of resources (vv. 11-13).**

III. Job's pain is magnified by rejection (vv. 14-23).

A. His friends are not reliable (vv. 14-20).

**B. His friends are unwilling to take the risk
(vv. 21-23).**

IV. Job requests care from his friends (vv. 24-30).

A. Their reproof is meaningless (vv. 24-27).

B. Their love would be reassuring (vv. 28-30).
