 - B. His life was preserved by God's care (v. 12).**
 - C. He feels God has concealed His plan (vv. 13-17).**

III. Job longs for his life to cease (vv. 18-22).

A. He questions God about his continuation (vv. 18-19).

B. He wants some cheer before death (vv. 20-22).
