 - A. Job feels God is avoiding him (vv. 11-13).**
 - B. Job has no answer for God (vv. 14-18).**
 - C. Job assesses God as mighty (vv. 19-24).**

**III. Job is desperate for an arbitrator
(vv. 25-35).**

**A. Job is afraid of further suffering
(vv. 25-31).**

**B. Job knows he cannot argue with God
(vv. 32-35).**
