**II. Job's faith in God does not waver (vv. 13-19).**

**A. He wants to have a face to face with God (vv. 13-16).**

**B. He wants to be treated fairly (vv. 17-19).**

**III. Job wants the issue finalized (vv. 20-28).**

**A. He does not want to fear the meeting (vv. 20-22).**

**B. He wants to know his faults (vv. 23-28).**
