II. The confidence of renewal (vv. 13-17).

A. Job longs to be concealed from heartache (v. 13).

B. Job longs to hear God's call (vv. 14-15).

C. Job longs for his iniquity to be covered (vv. 16-17).

III. The control of God (vv. 18-22).

A. Job feels God has crumbled his hope (vv. 18-19).

B. Job feels his life is going to cease (vv. 20-22).
