Job 22 p. 431 I. Job is <u>presented</u> as a wicked sinner (vv. 1-11).
A. Is Job's <u>piety</u> noticed by God (vv. 1-4)?
B. Is Job's <u>pity</u> for others missing (vv. 5-11)?

- II. Job is <u>perceived</u> to be a secret sinner (vv. 12-20).
  - A. His is <u>proposed</u> as ignoring God's omniscience (vv. 12-14).
  - B. He is <u>pointed</u> to the arrogance of the wicked (vv. 15-20).

- III. Job is <u>pressed</u> to repent of his sin (vv. 21-30).
  - A. Being at <u>peace</u> with God is attainable (vv. 21-25).
  - B. God <u>provides</u> restoration for the penitent (vv. 26-30).
