- I. Job determines to trust God (vv. 1-6).
 - A. He will speak nothing deceitful (vv. 1-4).
 - B. He will keep his integrity all his days (vv. 5-6).

II. Job desires his enemies to be punished by God (vv. 7-12).

A. His enemies do not delight in God (vv. 7-10).

B. He directs them towards God's justice (vv. 11-12).

III. God decides the timing of justice (vv. 13-23).

A. The descendants of the wicked suffer (vv. 13-15).

B. The possessions of the wicked are divided (vv. 16-19).

C. The dismal outcome of the wicked is sure (vv. 20-23).
