Job 41 p. 445

- I. God is master of all <u>creation</u> (vv. 1-11).
 - A. Man cannot control Leviathan (vv. 1-8).
 - B. Man cannot compare to God (vv. 9-11).

- II. Leviathan cannot be <u>contended</u> with (vv. 12-24).
 - A. God is <u>compelled</u> to describe Leviathan (vv. 12-17).
 - B. God seems <u>captivated</u> with His creation (vv. 18-24).

- III. Leviathan <u>causes</u> fear in man (vv. 25-34).
 - A. Leviathan <u>considers</u> man as non-threatening (vv. 25-30).
 - B. Leviathan is in a <u>class</u> of its own (vv. 31-34).

Conclusion: Do you look to God as your Master?
