I. God's law points out that our condition is desperate (vv. 16-22).

A. We can never do enough good deeds (vv. 16-19).

B. The requirement is complete devotion (vv. 20-22).

II. God's plan is to miraculously provide deliverance (vv. 23-26).

A. It is too difficult for us to earn salvation (vv. 23-24).

B. God is never deterred from carrying out His plan (vv. 25-26).

III. God's promise is rewards for His disciples (vv. 27-30).

A. Peter desires to know about their rewards (v. 27).

B. Following Christ reaps both present and future dividends (vv. 28-30).

Will you pray for God to do what you think is impossible, by transferring sinners from the domain of darkness to the kingdom of His beloved Son?
