II. Asa (Judah) was grounded in God's commands (vv. 9-24).

A. Asa restored the sacred gifts to the temple (vv. 9-15).

B. Asa arranged a guarantee of help (vv. 16-24).

III. Jeroboam's descendants met a gruesome end (vv. 25-34).

A. Nadab (Israel) governed for a short time (vv. 25-26).

B. Baasha (Israel) was granted the throne in fulfillment of prophecy (vv. 27-34).
